- I grew up in church in Nigeria—both my parents are pastors—so I was always around Christian activities like camps and youth programs. But even with all that, I didn't have a real personal relationship with God. As a teenager, I'd sometimes "repent" out of fear after hearing intense testimonies, but it never lasted because I didn't truly know God's love.

At 16, I left Nigeria for school. I went to church on and off, but by my first year of university I stopped completely, thinking I could figure life out on my own.

After graduating in 2018, I moved back to Calgary and started attending church again. In the summer of 2019, during a conference I helped plan, there was a prayer and worship session that changed everything. As I began to pray, I was deeply convicted and started weeping uncontrollably—real repentance, seeing my sin clearly for the first time. In that moment, a woman came to me and said, "God forgives you—don't worry." When I stood up, I knew I was surrendering my life to Jesus. That was the moment I truly gave my life to Christ, and He became my Lord and Savior.

My basic beliefs: I believe God is love and exists as one God in three persons—Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. I believe Jesus died for my sins as my substitute, rose again, and because He lives, I have new life. I believe the Holy Spirit lives in believers to help us grow, walk in truth, and serve God. I believe God has purpose for my life, including ministry—especially reaching and building young people. And I believe Jesus is coming back soon for His Church.
