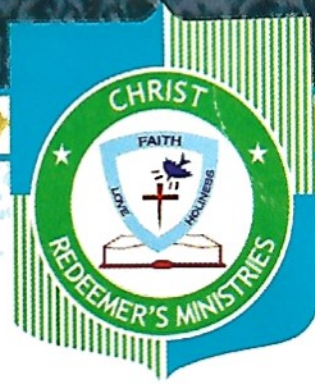

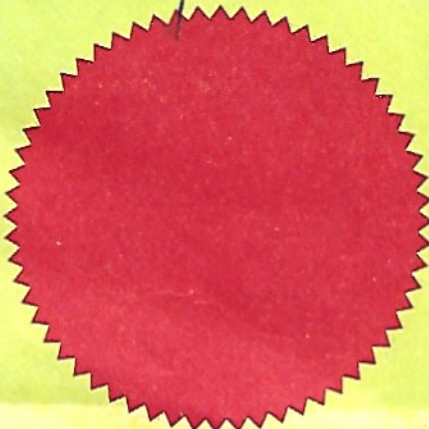

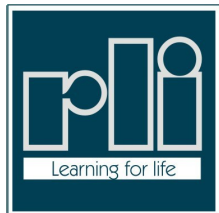

**Name:** Introduction to Church Management

**Description:**

DESCRIPTION AND PURPOSE OF COURSE:

This course provides an overview of the fundamentals of church administration and management of non-profit organizations. The course is designed for church leaders to study church business concepts and basic administrative practices to enhance the vision and ministry of the church.

The Course aims to educate students on all aspects of church management. It will touch core concepts such as servant leadership, volunteer management, facilities management, financial processes, budgets, fundraising, strategic planning, risk management, government regulations, constitution and bylaws, tax and legal issues, policies and procedures, pastoral/staff compensation and benefits.

#### COURSE COMPETENCIES AND LEARNING OBJECTIVES

After completion of this course, students should be able to:

1. Understand and apply biblical principles about church administration.
2. Define terms, policies, and operating procedures associated with Church administration and nonprofit organization management.
3. Identify the roles and responsibilities of the pastor, board, and officers for the financial management of the local church.
4. Develop a church budget, analyze financial reports, and implement financial processes for the church.
5. Identify and Implement management principles, procedures, and techniques to improve the effectiveness of the local church's operations.
6. Develop an understanding of the various areas of church administration including personnel, finance, legal, property management, risk management, technology and appropriate protocols and policies for each area.

**RESOURCES:** Students must be prepared for the first day of the class and should have all the required materials.

### MGMT 2213

**Name:** Pastoral Leadership Theology

**Description:**

This course investigates the theology that drives pastoral leadership. It explores the pastoral models of the patriarchs, the prophets, and the apostles. It especially addresses what drove the pastorate in the early Church. It addresses the historic contribution of the certain stream of the church to our current understanding of what it means to be a pastor (Augustinian Perspective). The core focus of the course is on the spiritual disciplines required for a successful pastoral ministry.

### MGMT 2223

**Name:** Pastoral Leadership - Praxis

**Description:**

This Course looks at the praxis of pastoral ministry. Praxis is defined as the process by which a theory, lesson, or skill is enacted, practiced, embodied, or realized. We will look at what is required to be efficient in the delivery of the Christian message within the Church today. It explains the necessary tools required in ministry as a pastor within a Church context.
