- The ELYT program is designed as a platform to raise future leaders and Ministers for RCCG North America. The goal is to identify, train and mentor youth with clear potentials for leadership in various domains. I was the pioneer operations director of the program.
- Every year we would select from across the United States a group of academically sound and self-driven young people, to attend a two-week all-expense paid summer camping program at Greenville Texas. We train them in Ministry and leadership programs while also focusing on areas such as Performing Arts (Drama & Music) and Sports with ministry at the center.
- I oversaw preparing program content, organization and overall supervision of the camp and programs. I functioned as a live-in camp director during the duration of the camp. I was

- The Winners Assembly is a church primarily focused on ministering to homeless people in South Dallas. - I was assigned primarily to provide spiritual care for patients in Neuro-surgery, stroke and internal medicine unit for my first advanced unit. I was also assigned to Medicine/Respirology. I, however, covered other sections of the hospital as needed because of the limited number of spiritual caregivers on staff at the hospital.

- I was primarily assigned to the Oncology and Palliative care units for my second basic CPE unit. I also had to respond to referrals in Labor & Delivery, Adult Mental Health, Elder Care, and other units in the hospital.
